#### 1. Raid of 10,000 pirated CD softwares in the two malls of Jakarta



Civil servant (PPNS) Directorate General of Intellectual Property with BSA (Business Software Association) and the Indonesian

Police held a raid of software Copyright Infringement in two places in Jakarta that is Ambassador Mall and Ratu Plaza Mall on **April 5, 2012**. This action was carried out based on a report from BSA (Business Software Association) on February 10, 2012 to the office of the Directorate General of Intellectual Property.

These pirated 10,000 software CDs were seized in the two malls. Price range of the pirated CD is at 5% of the original, Rp. 50-60.000 while the original around Rp. 1.000.000 per software. This raid will be conducted regularly in random places throughout Indonesia with the hope that the retainer may give instruction to the retaineer not to sell the pirated software.
